Number of Apply 1 choices

The number of applications an applicant has made in Apply 1. An applicant may make up to three applications in Apply 1.

Applicant Domicile (UK/EU/Not EU)

Applicant's area of permanent residence summarised at a high level. This variable is derived from domicile as declared by the applicant. Split by the following values: 'UK', 'EU (excluding UK)' and 'Not EU'. Please note: The Channel Islands and the Isle of Man have been assigned as 'Not EU'. Cycle year

The application year in which the application was processed.

Applicants
