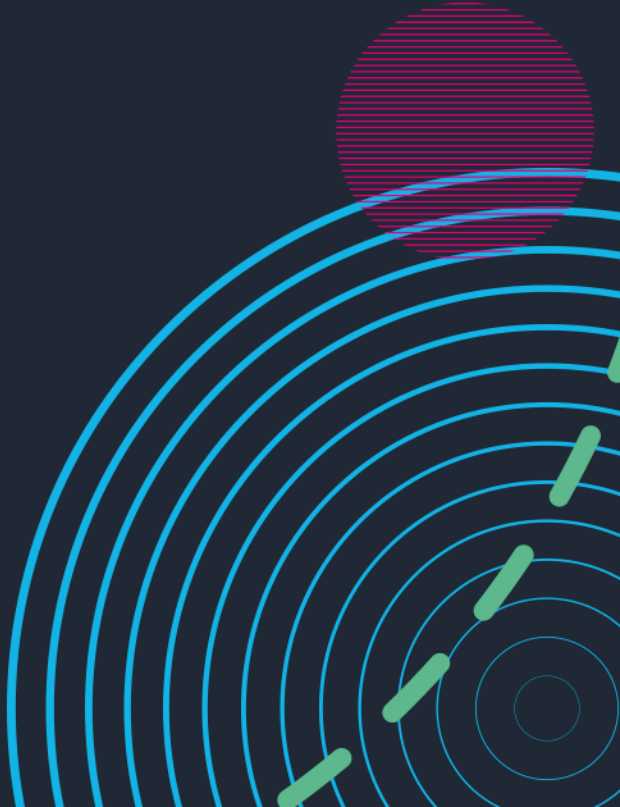

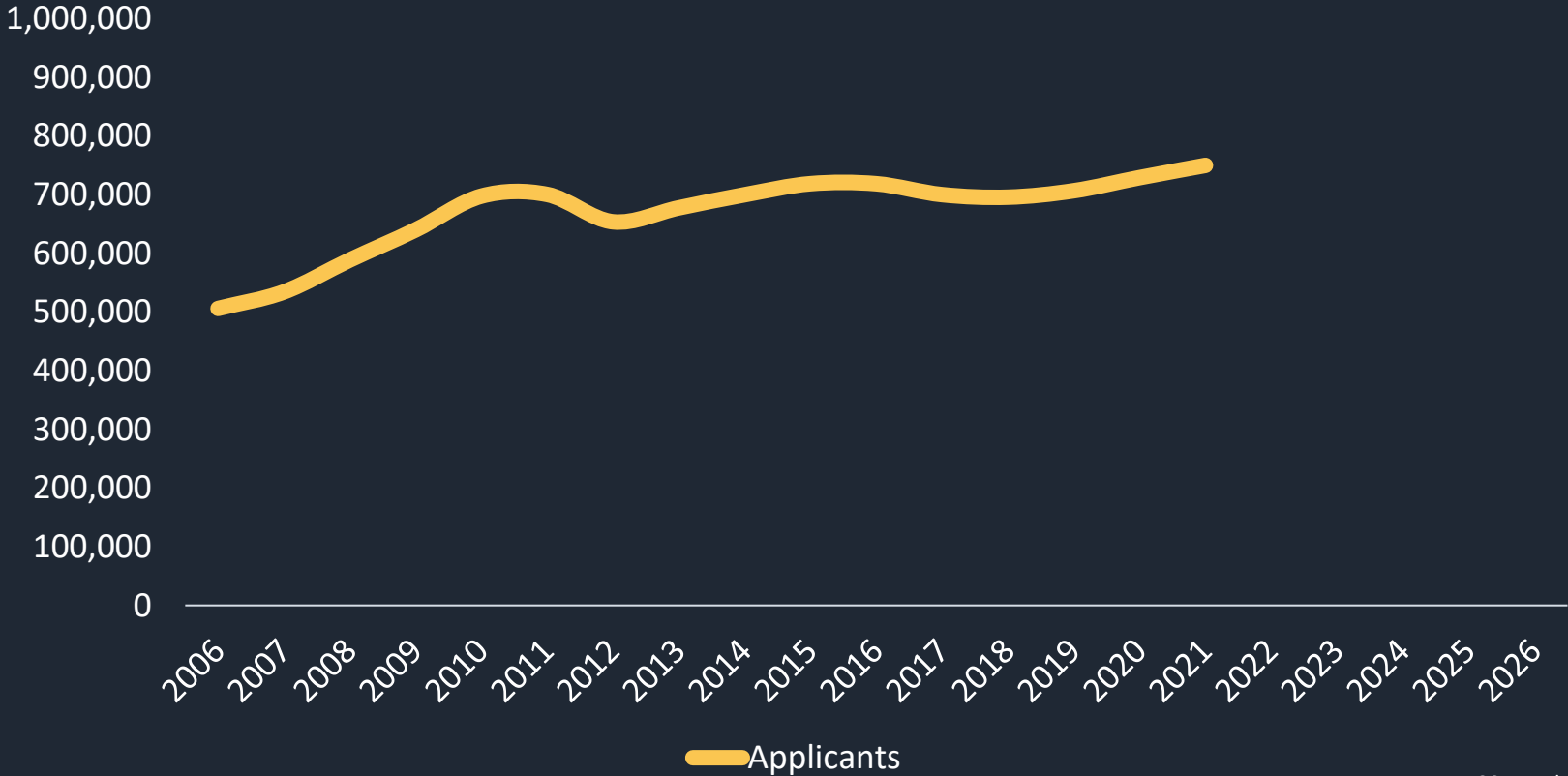

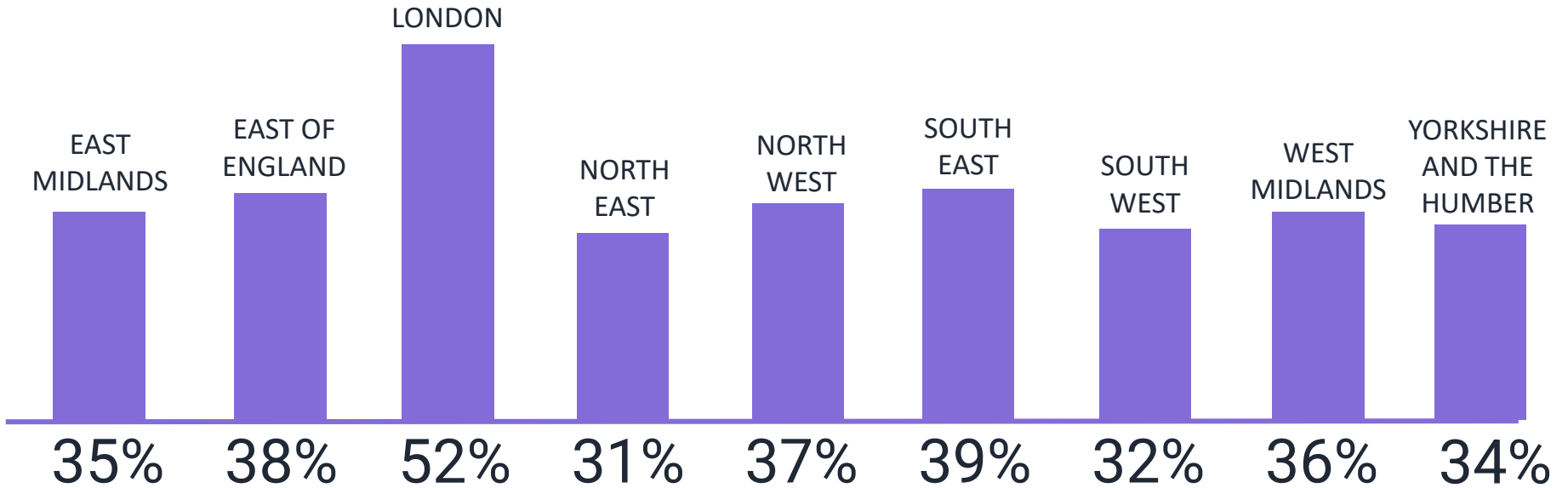
Regional Gap Widening

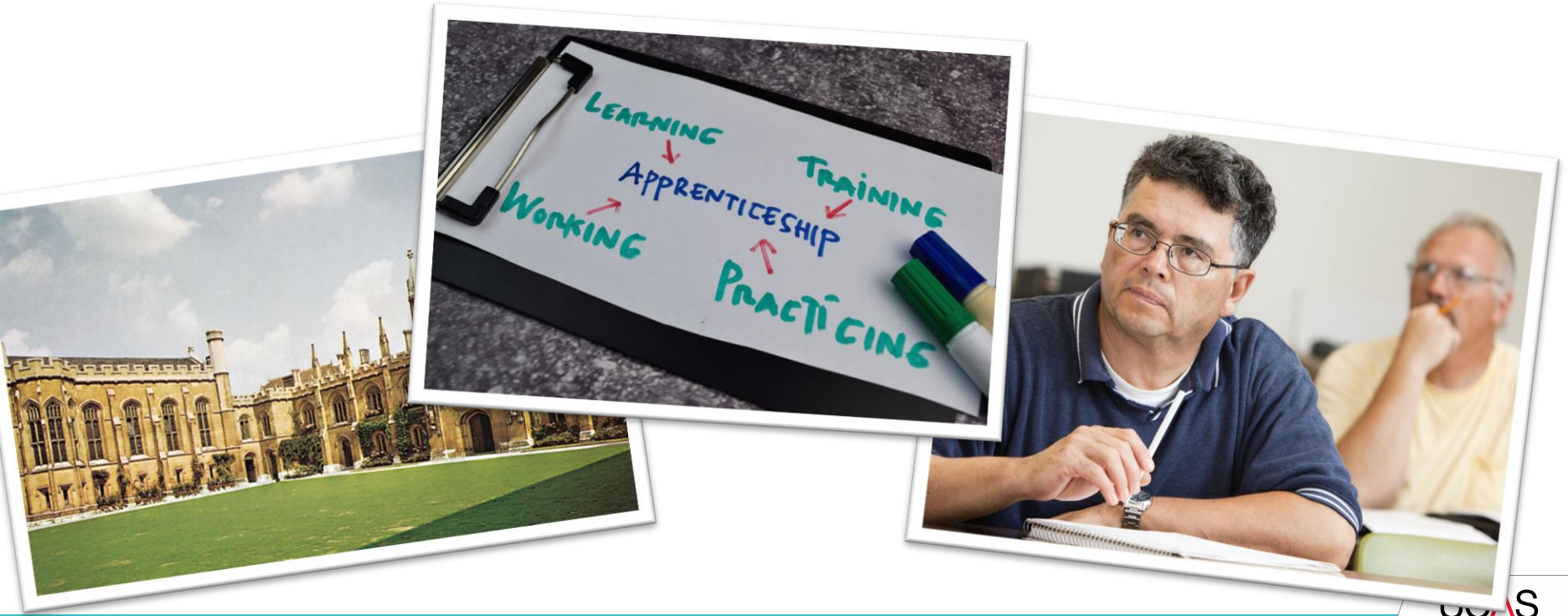

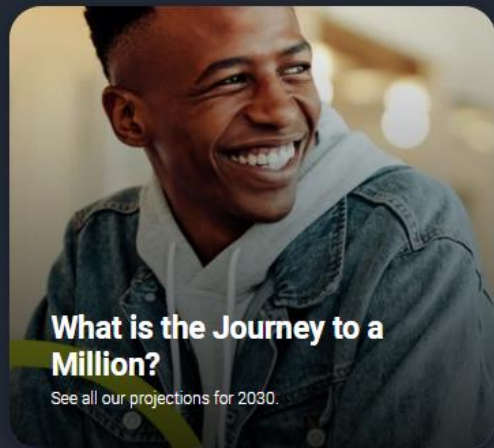
JOURNEY TO A MILLION

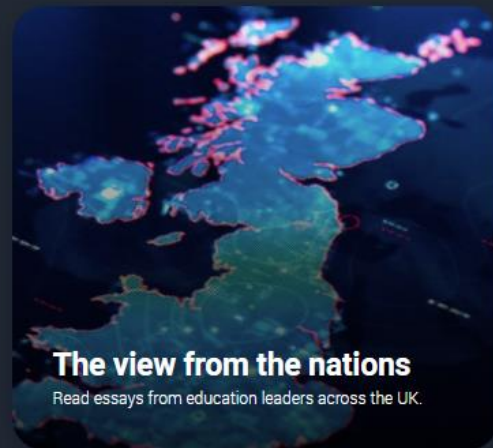
