## TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

To ensure a smooth and steady flow of coach traffic in and around the University of Bedfordshire, we have produced an important set of guidelines for teachers and coach drivers

- Please follow directions to the University of Bedfordshire (postcode MK419EA)
- On arrival there will be signs and event staff directing coaches to a designated drop off point.
- Please stick to your pre-arranged arrival time as we have approximately 10,000 visitors arriving by coach over the duration of the event
- If your coach is significantly early you will be asked to keep your students on the coach until your allocated arrival time. Please ensure your coach driver is aware of this
- Upon arrival each coach will receive a short briefing from a member of the event staff before the students disembark. At this time we will need to collect the following pieces of information from a member of school staff on each coach, so please ensure they have this information to hand:
- o School/College name
- o Contact name of staff member on site
- o Expected departure time
- o Emergency contact number
- o Coach company name
- $\bullet$  The coach pick up location is the same as the coach drop off location.

#### **Cars and Parking**

- $\bullet$  The University of Bedfordshire has ample parking for those wishing to travel to the exhibition by car
- Please follow directions to the University of Bedfordshire (postcode MK41 9EA)
- On campus, please follow the signs to the car parks then proceed to the exhibition registration area






## WHILST YOU'RE HERE

## WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, please head to the welcome marquee. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk in the welcome marquee.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket — both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue may be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.
