GETTING HERE

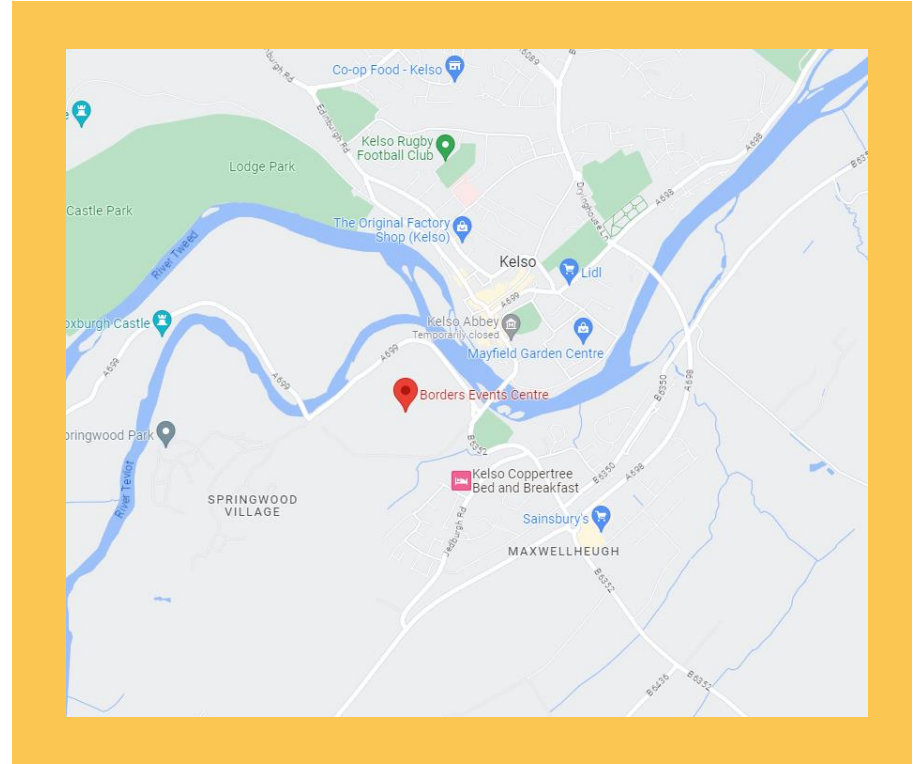
Travelling by car or coach?

The venue is on the outskirts of Kelso, across the old bridge. From the town centre, cross the bridge, and the gates to the show field are opposite the River Tweed. Through the gates, turn right, and follow the road towards the large building which houses the event.

The postcode for the venue is TD5 8LS.

Where can I park my car?

There is free parking available on-site. Please follow the direction of the signage and event staff, and enter the site through the main entrance.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

Please follow the directions of the signage and event staff on arrival.

If you're travelling by coach, please enter the site through the main entrance, and event staff will direct you to the coach drop-off and pick-up area. Please make sure students know what time and where to meet for their return journey.

Due to the expected number of visitors, please don't arrive any earlier than 15 minutes before your booked session time.

Once visitors have been dropped off, coaches will be directed to the coach parking by event staff.




Travelling by Train?

When you arrive

 On arrival, please head to the entrance of the Springwood Pavilion at Borders Events Centre. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.

 Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

 Please be aware, we may be conducting random bag and wand searches upon entry. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

Accidents & near misses

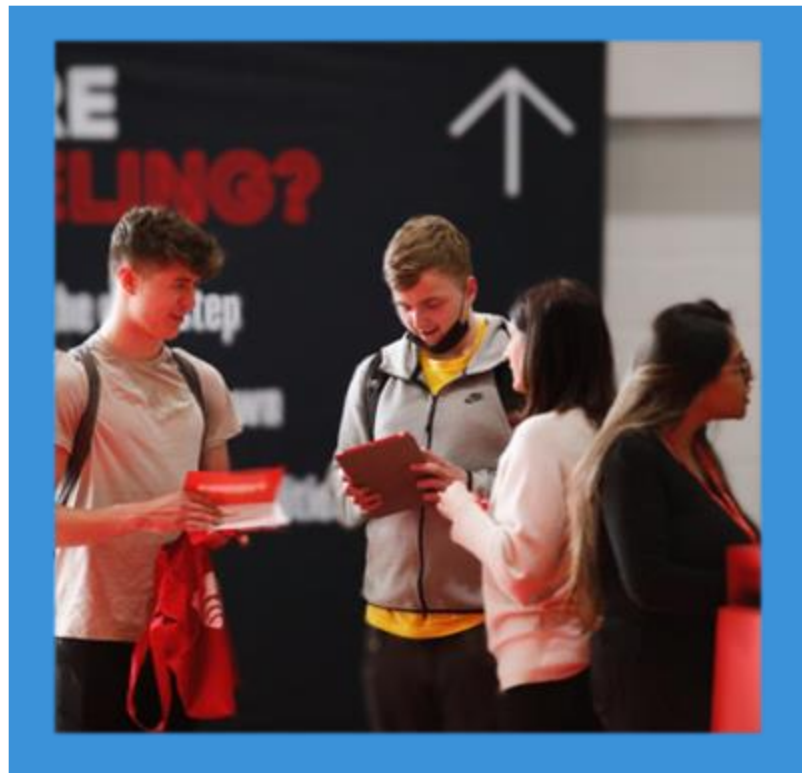
If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's desk immediately, located at the front of the hall.

- **Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?**

There is no cloakroom at this venue.

- **What insurance is in place for the event?**

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover.
