## CAR PARKING

Parking permits will be suspended on Thursday 13 June 2024. However, all other parking conditions will still apply, whereby a charge will be incurred if the parking conditions are breached. Please refer to the noticeboards on campus for parking conditions and only park in a designated parking bay. Student ambassadors will be around from 08:00 to assist you with any unloading.

Car park 3 will be reserved for exhibitors only so all exhibitors are asked to print off the parking pass at the end of his pack and display it in the windscreen of your vehicle.

Please note that as this is a working day, parking close to the event after 09:00 may prove difficult.

# EVENT INFORMATION

## CATERING

Exhibitors will be provided with one free bottle of water. During the day, free tea and coffee will be available for you to collect from the Catalyst Café and the Catalyst Kitchen.

## INTERNET

To access the free Wi-Fi on campus, you will need to connect to EduRoam or to the 'Wi-Fi Guest' network. When you open an internet window, you will be asked to complete a short registration form. Once registered, you will have unlimited access to the internet.

## SCANNING

To take advantage of lead scanning at this event, you need to download the Smartlead UCAS and have purchased scanning for the UCAS Discovery events. You will need a license code per device per event which are assigned to you when you purchase the scanning. Make sure your staff at the event have been provided with the license codes.

You will find a guide to setting up your device and how to manage your data in the [Exhibitor zone](#) along with a Scanning Instructions document that you can share with your staff attending the event. Hard copies are also provided on your stand.

# LOGISTICS

## ARRIVAL

On arrival at the event, exhibitors should head to the organisers desk in the Sir Stanley Matthews Sports Centre, where they will need to register and obtain their exhibitor lanyard, which must be worn at all times.

To gain entry to the venue, you must register details of who will be attending before the event, through your ENet account – instructions on how to do this will be emailed to the lead booker.

## BUILD-UP

Build day and times: Wednesday 12 June 2024, 16:00 – 18:00

Event day and build time: Thursday 13 June 2024, 08:00 – 09:00

Exhibitors will be able to unload in the layby outside the Sir Stanley Matthews Sports Centre. Following this they will then need to move their vehicle to Car Park 3, which has been reserved for exhibitor parking.

If you think you might need extra time to build your stand (outside the build-up times stated above), please contact [events@ucas.ac.uk](mailto:events@ucas.ac.uk). In some circumstances, early access to the venue on the build-up day may be given, but this is only with the advance permission of the organiser. If advance permission has not been granted, exhibitors will be turned away from the venue until the exhibitor build-up session starts.

## BREAKDOWN

Breakdown time: Thursday 13 June 2024, 14:30 – 15:30

Exhibitors must remain on their stands, and not start dismantling them until the exhibition is clear of visitors. To help facilitate this, and ensure health and safety is maintained, the loading doors will stay closed until the venue is clear of visitors.

If exhibitors start dismantling stands while the event is still open, there will be no alternative but to close the exhibition, irrespective of how many visitors remain in the hall, due to health and safety.
