GETTING HERE

Travelling by car or coach?

By car, Utilita Arena Newcastle is 3 minutes from the A1 North -South route. Take the A184 signposted 'City Centre', then follow the A189 over the Redheugh Bridge. When in the vicinity of the Arena, follow the signs to the appropriate car parks.

The full address is - Utilita Arena Newcastle, Arena Way, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7NA.

9 Where can I park my car?

Onsite car parking is available at the rear of Utilita Arena Newcastle. Parking is free for visitors however please note ANPR cameras are in use at the venue

If you're planning on parking at the venue please follow the steps below within 30 minutes of your arrival into the car park

• Go to pay on the RingGo app and enter the code (which UCAS will email to you on 20 June) rather than the location code. If you do not receive the code, please email <u>events@ucas.ac.uk</u>

.• Enter the vehicle registration (must be done within 30 minutes of coming onto site) and the price will come up as free parking.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

Please follow the instructions of traffic marshals who will be on hand to guide you through the coach operation. There is a designated drop-off and pick-up area, located at the side of the venue.

Once students are dropped off, coaches will be signposted to the onsite parking, and should return to the drop-off point once they are ready to pick up students. Groups must be fully assembled before calling your coach to collect the group.

Coach passes will be sent to the group leader around 1-2 weeks before the exhibition, and must be clearly displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle.

• Travelling by Train?

Newcastle Central Train Station, situated on Neville Street is around a 15min walk from Utilita Arena Newcastle providing connections to the local Metro Service. Newcastle Central Station is on the East Coast Main Line service connecting people to regional and national destinations including Newcastle International Airport.

When you arrive

On arrival, please head to the main entrance of the Utilita Arena. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Accidents & near misses


If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's office immediately, located at the front of the hall.

Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?

What insurance is in place for the event?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover.
