

GETTING HERE

Travelling by coach or minibus?

There is a designated drop-off and pick-up area located on the water side of the ACC Liverpool (Sat Nav – L3 4FP). Traffic marshals will direct your coach driver and tell you when to disembark. If you have informed UCAS you will be travelling by coach, a coach pass will be emailed to you before the event, please have this to display.

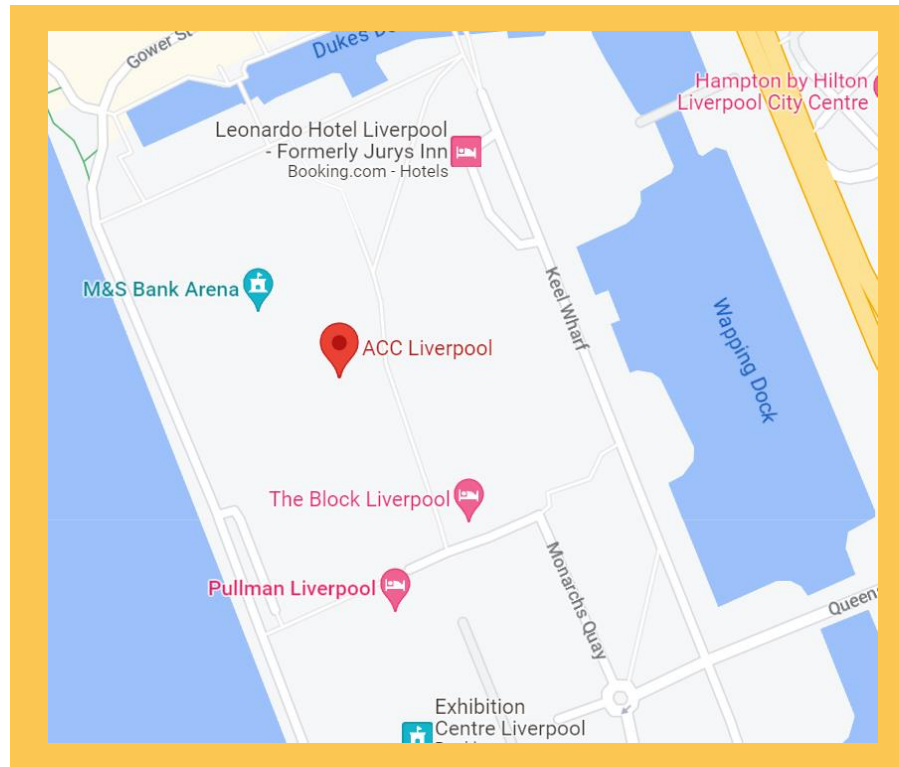
When you are ready to leave the exhibition, please make sure all your students are together and proceed along the walkway, back to the coach pick-up point.

When you arrive



On arrival, please head to the main entrance of Exhibition Centre Liverpool (ECL). Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.



Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Accidents & near misses

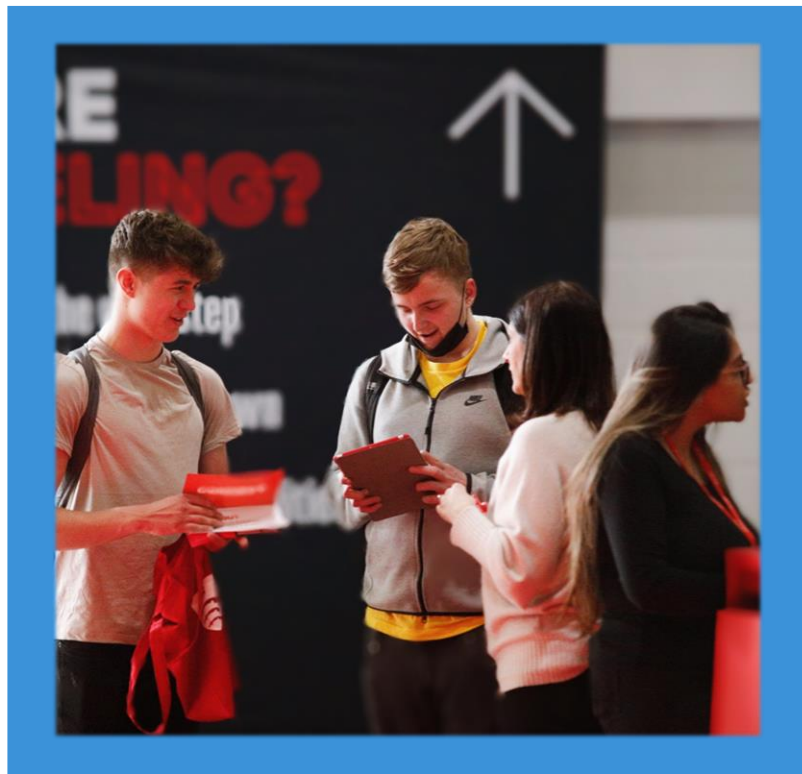
If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's office immediately, located along the corridor.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

UCAS

Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?

Unfortunately, there is no cloakroom service at this event. We advise that visitors do not bring big bags or to store them more securely on the coach or vehicle they arrive in. Bag searches will be in operation and therefore a group with many bags can cause delay to entry.

What insurance is in place for the event?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

What happens to any lost property?

All property found in the hall will be handed to the venue's reception desk in the foyer and will be retained for 12 weeks. If, after 12 weeks, no claim in respect of the property has been made by any person, the venue has the right to dispose or donate the item.

Can I smoke/vape on site?

ACC Liverpool operates a strict no smoking policy in the venue and would ask for your full cooperation in ensuring this is complied with. This includes the use of e-cigarettes.

What security is there?

Security is present at the event throughout. If you are a victim of theft, please report it to the organiser's office immediately.
