





Top tips for 2025 applications

Here are the latest resources available to support you and your students when the adviser portal opens at 17:00 (UK time) 7 May and applications open in the Hub on 14 May.

- Get ready for the 2025 cycle by using the filtering option in the portal to bulk download your 2022-2023 applications by group or student cohort.
- 2. Ensure students keep up to date with a school and personal email address on their Hub account. They can login with either, but their personal one should be marked as primary to ensure they get updates on their application during school holidays.
- Your students can already start their research in the UCAS
 Hub, saving favourite subjects, courses, locations and more.

The Adviser Portal will be unavailable from 13:00 -17:00 on 7 May to prepare for the 2025 cycle launch.



Personal statement guidance

A reminder that any changes to the personal statement will not be taking effect until the 2026 cycle (launching May 2025). The format for this current 2025 application cycle remains the same. We will be releasing guidance on the changes to schools and colleges in June.
