
TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

If you are arriving by car or minibus, please park in the Duke Orwell Quay Car Park, on Duke Street, IP3 OBF. This is a public car park and is pay per hour £1.70 per hour, or £6.35 all day.

Please note, coach parking is not available.

The drop off and pick up point will be signposted, all coaches should head to Duke Street, down University Avenue (IP3 ODN) along the Quayside, where they will drop students off outside Athena Hall / James Hehir Building. Coaches will then be directed off the Quayside via Patteson Road.

Coaches will pick-up from the same location and both coaches and groups should ensure prompt arrival at the pick-up point.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, please head to the main entrance located in the Waterfront Building. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk which is also found in the Waterfront Building.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket — both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue may be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES


If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the Waterfront Building reception.
