GETTING HERE





Travelling by car or coach?


From the North and West: the venue is easily situated just off the A47 Norwich Southern Bypass at the A1074 Longwater Interchange. From the South and East: Travel to Norwich via the A11 from London and beyond or on the A140 from Ipswich and take the A47 westbound and follow the signs for Norfolk Showground.

You can also use postcode <u>NR5 0TP</u> on a satnav.

Where can I park my car?

There is free parking available on-site. Please follow the direction of the traffic marshals and enter the site through the main entrance (gate 1/44 – opposite Premier Inn), where they'll direct you to the designated car park.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

If you're travelling by coach or minibus, please follow the directions of the traffic marshals.

If you're travelling by coach, please enter the site through the main entrance (gate 1/44 – opposite Premier Inn), and traffic marshals will direct you to the coach drop-off and pick-up area. Please make sure students know what time and where to meet for their return journey. Due to the expected number of visitors, please don't arrive any earlier than 15 minutes before your booked session time.

Once visitors have been dropped off, coaches will be directed to the coach parking by traffic marshals. Please note that coach passes are not required for this event.



Travelling by Train?

The nearest train station is Norwich, approximately 7 miles away. Taxis and buses are available from the station, but it may be advisable to book a taxi in advance.

When you arrive

On arrival, please head to the main entrance of the Norfolk Showground Arena. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have preregistered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue will be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

Accidents & near misses


If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's desk immediately, located at the front of the hall.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS UCAS

Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?

There is not a cloakroom service at this venue. It is suggested that bags are left on coaches where possible. Do not leave bags unattended anywhere at the event.

What insurance is in place for the event?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

What happens to any lost property?

All property found in the hall and handed to the organisers desk will be taken back to the UCAS offices and held for 2 weeks. After 2 weeks, if no claim in respect of that property has been made by any person, UCAS reserves the right to dispose of the item or donate it to charity.

Can I smoke/vape on site?

Norfolk Showground Arena operates a strict no smoking policy in the venue and would ask for your full cooperation in ensuring this is complied with. This includes e-cigarettes.
