Travelling by coach or minibus?

Enter site via Gate 1 (What 3 Words: hope.busy.assume) and turn right at the roundabout to access the designated drop-off/pick-up point. 
When you are ready to leave the exhibition, please make sure all your students are together and proceed along the walkway, back to the coach pick-up point.




When you arrive

On arrival, please head to the main entrance of The Lowland Hall at the Royal Highland Centre. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting the exhibition stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue will be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

Accidents & near misses


If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's office immediately.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS UCAS

Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?

Unfortunately, there is no cloakroom service at this event. We advise that visitors do not bring big bags or to store them within your coach or vehicle when accessing the event. Bag searches will be in operation and therefore a group with many bags can cause delay on entry.

What insurance is in place for the event?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

What happens to any lost property?

All property found in the hall will be handed to the venue's reception desk or organiser's office and will be retained for 5 days. If, after 5 days, no claim in respect of the property has been made by any person, the venue has the right to dispose or donate the item. If the item is of value, it will be passed to the local police station to the venue.

Can I smoke/vape on site?

There is a strict no smoking/vaping policy inside the venue, if you wish, you can smoke/vape anywhere outside the venue.

What security is there?

Security is present at the event throughout. If you are a victim of theft, please report it to the organiser's office immediately.
