ACCESSIBILITY

To gain entry to the venue, exhibitor lanyards must be worn at all times. Your lanyard will be ready to collect when you arrive, from the exhibitor check-in desk in the Sir Ian Wood Building entrance foyer. To gain entry to the venue, you must register details of who will be attending before the event, through your ENet account – instructions on how to do this will be emailed to the lead booker. CARPARKING

We have allocated 1 parking space per exhibitor for 3rd and 4th September 2024. In order to register for your space, please email <u>studentrecruitment@rgu.ac.uk</u> no later than Wednesday the 28th of August with the make, colour, model and registration number of the car. If you are hiring a car and don't have these details, please let us know and we can reserve you a space in the meantime. Confirmation of these details will need to be provided on arrival if not known prior to the event.

Parking on campus is free of charge to registered visitor vehicles parked in any white or red space on-campus (please do not park in disabled or drop-off parking bays). The closest car park to the Sir Ian Wood Building is located opposite the building and is best accessed via Entrance 1 off Garthdee Road. Upon entering the campus follow the road to the right and enter the first car park on your right. If this car park is full you will find an overflow carpark on your right hand side as you continue through campus.

CATERING

SCANNING

To take advantage of lead scanning at this event, you need to download the Smartlead UCAS and have purchased scanning for the UCAS/Discovery events. You will need a license code per device per event which are assigned to you when you purchase the scanning. Make sure your staff at the event have been provided with the license codes.

You will find a guide to setting up your device and how to manage your data in the Exhibitor zone [link] along with a Scanning Instructions document that you can share with your staff attending the event. Hard copies are also provided on your stand.

ARRIVAL

Upon arrival please go directly to the Sir Ian Wood Building main entrance. If you need to unload items or require assistance, please park your vehicle at the Garthdee Campus car park and make your way to the Sir Ian Wood Building reception to register and let the staff know your car registration details (please take a note of your car registration number, colour and make). Once you have registered the reception staff/ organisers will be able to assist you further.

STORAGE

A temporary storage space for exhibition materials has been allocated in the Ishbel Gordon Building, adjacent to the Sir Ian Wood Building. If you require use of the storage area, a member of the events staff can arrange for your materials to be transported and stored appropriately.

LOGISTICS



BREAKDOWN

Breakdown time: Wednesday 4 September 2024 from 15:30-18:00

Exhibitors must remain on their stands, and not start dismantling them until the exhibition is clear of visitors. We anticipate this to be 10 to 15 minutes after the exhibition closes, at 15:00 on 4 September 2024. To help facilitate this, and ensure health and safety is maintained, the loading doors will stay closed until the venue is clear of visitors.

If exhibitors start dismantling stands while the event is still open, there will be no alternative but to close the exhibition, irrespective of how many visitors remain in the hall – this is standard industry practice, in line with guidance in the eGuide. This is because stands which are broken down while visitors are still in the hall pose a health and safety risk. As stated in the exhibitors' code of conduct, all issues raised will be logged and reviewed regularly by UCAS and HELOA. The same principles apply for dismantling, as accessing.

Our Sir Ian Wood Building is open for teaching during the event so please take care when dismantling stands as staff and students may need access.

If you think you might need extra time to build your stand (outside the build-up times stated previously), please contact <u>events@ucas.ac.uk</u>. In some circumstances, early access to the venue on the build-up day may be given, but this is only with the advance permission of the organiser. If advance permission has not been granted, exhibitors will be turned away from the venue until the exhibitor build-up session starts.
