

• TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

Parking in the college car park will be extremely limited. Alternative parking is available at the train station car park and in the town centre car parks, although you will be charged for this. Parking is also available at Morrisons, however there are time restrictions on this.

If you are considering alternative transport, our Kilmarnock Campus is a one minute walk from the train station and a five minute walk from the bus station.

There is a drop off point for coaches on the road that runs parallel to the college car park, however double yellow lines prevent coaches from parking here.






WHILST YOU'RE HERE

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- On arrival you can use the front or back doors to enter the building. The exhibition area is located in the atrium on the ground floor. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk.
- Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES


If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it at the UCAS General Information desk immediately.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



WHAT INSURANCE IS IN PLACE FOR THE EVENT?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. WHAT HAPPENS TO ANY LOST PROPERTY?

CAN I SMOKE/VAPE ON SITE?

Ayrshire College adopts the protocol that sets out the approach toward a smoke free environment.
