Parking is free of charge. Please press the intercom on arrival and state that you are here for the UCAS Discovery Exhibition.




#### **TRAVELLING BY COACH?**

ALTERNATIVE PARKING WILL BE ADVISED ON THE DAY.






## WHILST YOU'RE HERE

#### WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, please head to the main entrance located in the Senate Building. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk on the ground floor of the Senate Building.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.


# **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**
