GETTING HERE



Travelling by car or coach?

From M4 – exit the M4 at Junction 19 onto the M32. Exit the M32 at Junction 1. Turn right at the roundabout onto the A4174 ring road, following signs for Filton and Bristol Parkway railway station. Go past the Holiday Inn on the left, through the first set of lights at the junction towards UWE and Bristol Business Park, then, turn left at the second set of traffic lights, into UWE North Entrance.

From M5 – exit the M5 at Junction 15 onto the M4 eastbound towards London. Exit the M4 at Junction19 onto the M32, and follow the directions from the M4 given above.

From the south – from Bristol City Centre, follow signs for the M32. Exit M32 at Junction 1. Turn left onto the A4174 ring road, and follow the directions above

Where can I park my car?

There is limited free parking available on-site, please follow the direction of the traffic marshals. We encourage car sharing or public transport.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

If you're travelling by coach or minibus, please follow the directions of the traffic marshals.

If you are travelling by coach, there is a designated drop-off and pick-up area located to the front of the venue. Once students have disembarked, your coach will need to leave the site until your designated collection time. Please note, there is no on-site coach parking available, but do ensure your coach pass is visible at all times.

Coach passes will be sent to the group leader a week before the exhibition.



Travelling by Train?

The nearest rail stations are Bristol Parkway and Filton Abbey Wood, approximately 20-minutes' walk to the venue.

When you arrive

On arrival, please head to the main entrance of the Enterprise Park 1. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue will be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

Accidents & near misses


If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's desk immediately, located at the front of the building.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS UCAS

Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?

There is not a cloakroom service at this venue. It is suggested that bags are left on coaches where possible. Do not leave bags unattended anywhere at the event.

What insurance is in place for the event?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

What happens to any lost property?

All property found in the hall and handed to the organisers desk will be taken back to the UCAS offices and held for 2 weeks. After 2 weeks, if no claim in respect of that property has been made by any person, UCAS reserves the right to dispose of the item or donate it to charity.
