

UCAS Data Release Guidance

The structure of the data files published by UCAS has been updated so that each file contains more information.

Please note that the 'All' category has been added to each variable, to have a record of the subtotals within each set of breakdowns, without rounding errors. For this reason, care must be taken when performing calculations on the data tables, for example summing a column of numbers, so that the 'All' category is not included in the summation.

A column can be filtered to only include 'All' if you want to remove the breakdown from a summary. If you wish to pivot the data, you may want to remove the 'All' category to avoid including it in the totals. Please note that for the 2021 End of Cycle release high level domicile splits between UK and International with intermediate level domicile splitting between UK, EU (excluding the UK) and Non EU. Also that Gibraltar has been classified as EU (excluding the UK) in this release.
